## DECLARATION ON EXEMPTION FROM TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS

Third-country nationals can be exempt from travel restrictions to Iceland during COVID-19, if they can demonstrate that their travel is essential, according to Regulation on Border Crossing No. 866/2017 with later amendments. The party in question must be able to provide proof of exemption as well as all necessary documents upon arrival to Iceland. *The final decision to allow or deny entry into the country is made by border guards upon arrival.*
